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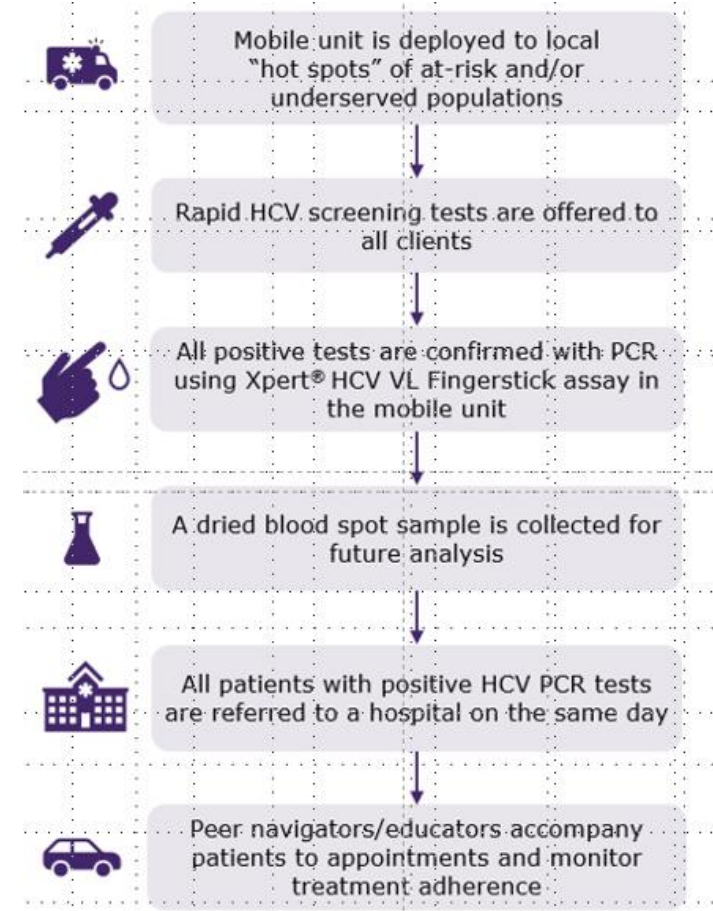
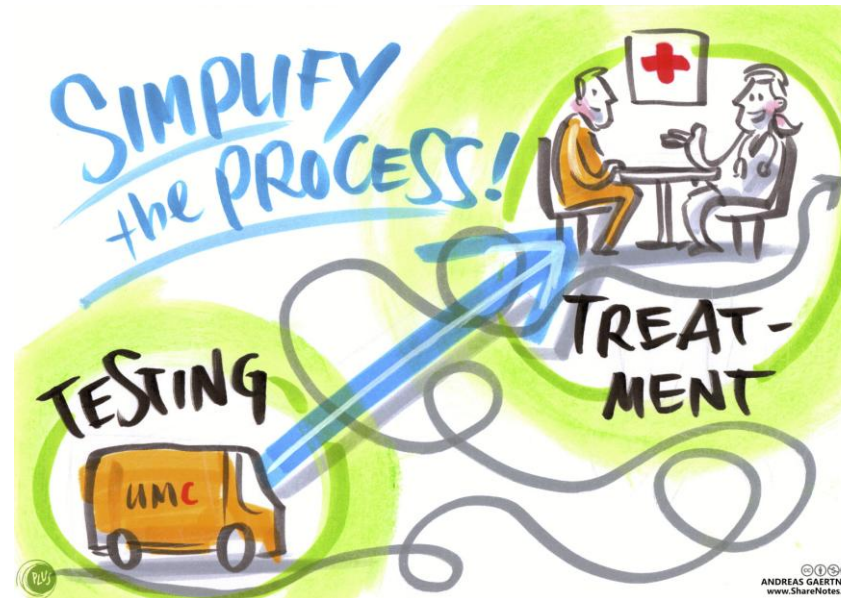
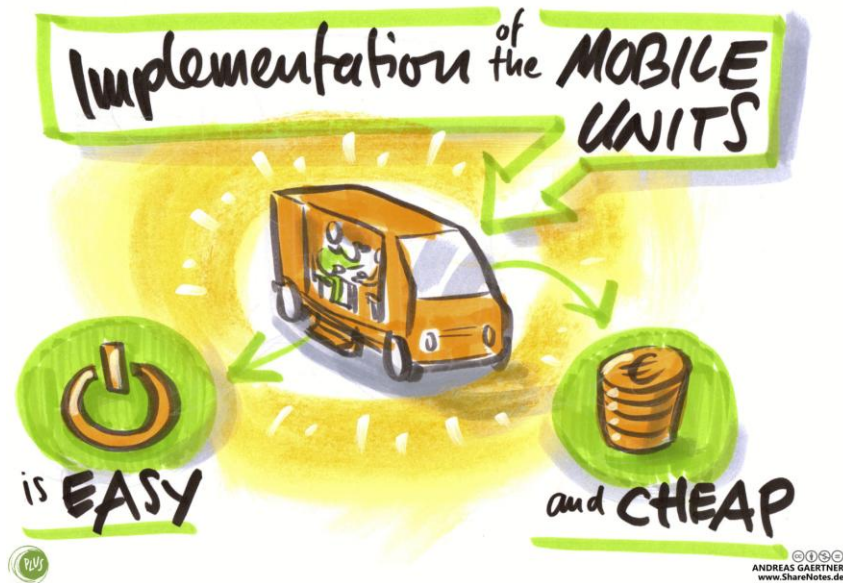


Why This Project Matters

- **Viral hepatitis** (HBV/HCV) remains a *silent epidemic* among Europe's most vulnerable populations
- **Underserved groups** (PWID, homeless, migrants, sex workers, incarcerated) face major barriers to testing and care
- **Traditional services** inadequate for these populations
- **Urgent need** to unify efforts, reduce health inequalities, and reach WHO's 2030 elimination targets
- **Mobile units** are effective but fragmented—no shared EU standards exist

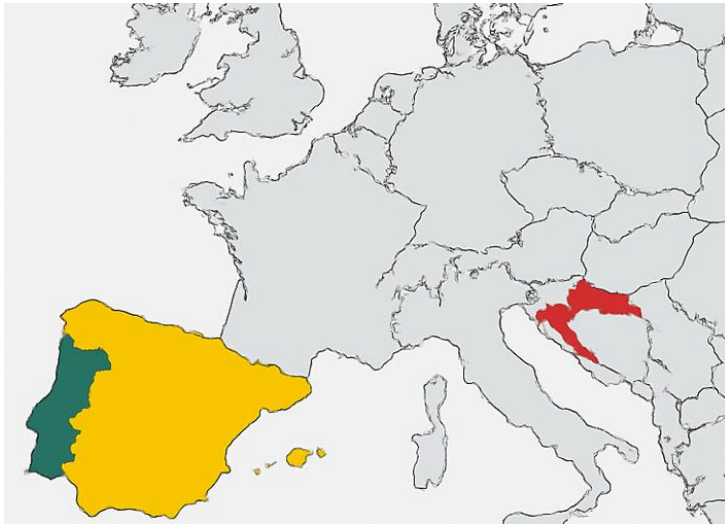

Toward a Shared Standard for Mobile Hepatitis Care

Hepatos, ADP & UCM join forces to harmonize processes across countries



- **Goal:** align workflows and standardize mobile unit services
- **Sharing experiences** to create a common care package
- **Building synergies** across countries for better outreach

This project creates a replicable, evidence-based model for *person-centered liver care* across Europe

MOBHOPE Objectives



- **Enhance prevention** of viral hepatitis and liver cancer through training and health promotion
- **Develop a cascade of care** using mobile outreach with RDTs and liver assessments
- **Conduct operational research** on prevalence, social determinants, and barriers to care
- **Assess and reduce stigma**, promoting human dignity through validated tools
- **Standardize and improve quality** of mobile liver health services across Europe





CE ESTE HEPATITA B?

Hepatita B este o boală a ficatului cauzată de un virus (VHB). Dacă nu este tratată, poate provoca probleme grave de sănătate, cum ar fi cancerul hepatic sau boli hepatice.

Testarea este singura modalitate de a ști dacă ai hepatită B.

Există un tratament extrem de eficient pentru hepatita B care ajută la prevenirea bolilor hepatice pentru a duce o viață normală. Tratatamentul este prescris numai de medicii specialiști. Cu toate acestea, nu toate persoanele cu hepatită B au nevoie de tratament. Din acest motiv, medicul specialist te va evalua pentru a stabili dacă ai sau nu nevoie de acesta.

Majoritatea persoanelor cu hepatită B nu știu că sunt infectate. Acest lucru se datorează faptului că nu prezintă simptome și, prin urmare, nu-și realizează probele corespunzătoare pentru diagnostic. Aceste persoane ar putea transmite infecția altora, cum ar fi membri ai familiei sau prieteni.

Există un vaccin sigur și eficient pentru prevenirea infecției cu hepatita B. Acesta se administrează de obicei nou-născuților sau copiilor mici, în cazul în care nu știți dacă ți s-a administrat vaccinul împotriva hepatitei B, se poate face un test de sânge pentru a determina acest lucru.

What is Hepatitis B?

It is a liver disease caused by a virus (HBV). If left untreated, it can cause serious health problems (cirrhosis, liver cancer).

If you think you can't have symptoms, it is **VERY IMPORTANT** to get a diagnostic test, even if you have symptoms.

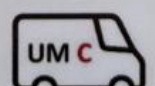

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WP2 – Cascade of Care & Operational Research

WP2 Objective

Develop and implement a cascade of care for viral hepatitis and liver diseases in vulnerable populations, through mobile outreach, testing, referral, and operational research.

◆ **Mobile Outreach**

- Deploy mobile units in high-need areas
- Provide RDTs & liver assessments (e.g. Fibroscan®)

◆ **Linkage to Care**

- Refer positive cases to specialized services
- Monitor time to treatment & care retention

◆ **Data & Research**

- Collect clinical, social & behavioral data
- Analyze prevalence, barriers & social determinants
- Use PROMs/PREMs & REDCap system

◆ **Continuous Improvement**

- Identify drop-offs in the care cascade
- Benchmark against best practices
- Engage stakeholders & update protocols
